

Application for Early Career Researcher Fellowships

AtlantiS Early Career Researcher (ECR) Fellowships provide financial support for postgraduate students and postdoctoral researchers to spend around 2-4 months as visitors at one of our research centres.

The purpose of AtlantiS ECR Fellowships is to support the career development of ECRs by enabling collaborative working with AtlantiS researchers, as well as access to AtlantiS facilities, data sets, model output and tools, and berths on AtlantiS cruises. The research carried out by the ECR during the Fellowship should enhance the AtlantiS objectives and build on the project's observations and/or modelling and/or technology development. <u>https://projects.noc.ac.uk/AtlantiS</u>

The AtlantiS ECR Fellowships are awarded through a competitive selection process and you can apply for one using this form. The funds associated with the Fellowships are intended to cover the cost of an extended visit to one of our centres (or for joining an AtlantiS cruise). They can be used for travel, temporary accommodation, and consumables associated with research during the Fellowship. It is therefore essential that the Fellowship applicants are registered as students, or employed as researchers for the period of the Fellowship, and that permission for the visit is given by supervisors or line managers (as appropriate).

To be eligible for a AtlantiS ECR Fellowship you must be a Masters or PhD student, or be employed as a researcher and have less than 6 years post-doctoral working experience (full time equivalent).

Applicants are expected to contact suitable researchers and discuss a visit with them before submitting this form, or send an email to the AtlantiS mailbox and request to be put in touch with a suitable researcher (atlantis_nc@noc.ac.uk).

Deadlines for fellowship applications are the last Friday in December, March and June each year, unless the application is associated with a cruise berth in which case the cruise berth application deadline applies (see academic engagement tab on the AtlantiS website for details of these dates).

As well as completing this form please email (to atlantis_nc@noc.ac.uk) a proposal for your Fellowship (maximum two pages) that includes:

- a title
- an outline of your intended research
- how the research builds on and enhances the AtlantiS programme
- the expected output of the Fellowship, e.g. journal article, new data set or product, new software, etc.
- cost estimates and justification for the financial support requested for the Fellowship.

The following wording must be included in all publications arising from work undertaken during AtlantiS ECR Fellowships:
